## Excursionist Arrivals by Mode of Transport and Point of Entry










#### **VISITOR & TOURIST RECEIPTS**



### Explanatory note:

- 1 Visitor- A visitor is a traveler taking a trip to a main destination outside his/her usual environment, for less than a year, for any main purpose (business, leisure or other personal purpose) other that to be employed by a resident entity in the country or place visitor.
- <sup>2</sup> Tourist (or overnight stay)- A visitor (inbound) is classified as a tourist (or overnight visitor), if his/her trip includes as overnight
- 3 Excursionist (or same day visitor)- A visitor (inbound) is classified as a same-day visitor (or excursionist) if his/her trip does not include an overnight stay. Source: UN Tourism
